Marie Curie

Marie Curie grew up in Warsaw, Poland where she was born on November 7, 1867. Her parents were both teachers. The child of two teachers, Marie, was taught to read and write early in life. She was a very bright child and did well in school. She had a sharp memory and worked hard on her studies. As Marie grew older, her family came upon tough times. Poland was under the control of Russia at that time. People were not even allowed to read or write anything in the Polish language. Her father lost his job because he was in favour of Polish rule. Marie lost her elder sister and mother to typhus and tuberculosis respectively. After graduating from high school, Marie wanted to attend a university, but this wasn't something that young women did in Poland during the years covering the period 1800 - 1900.
