Language is another problem. 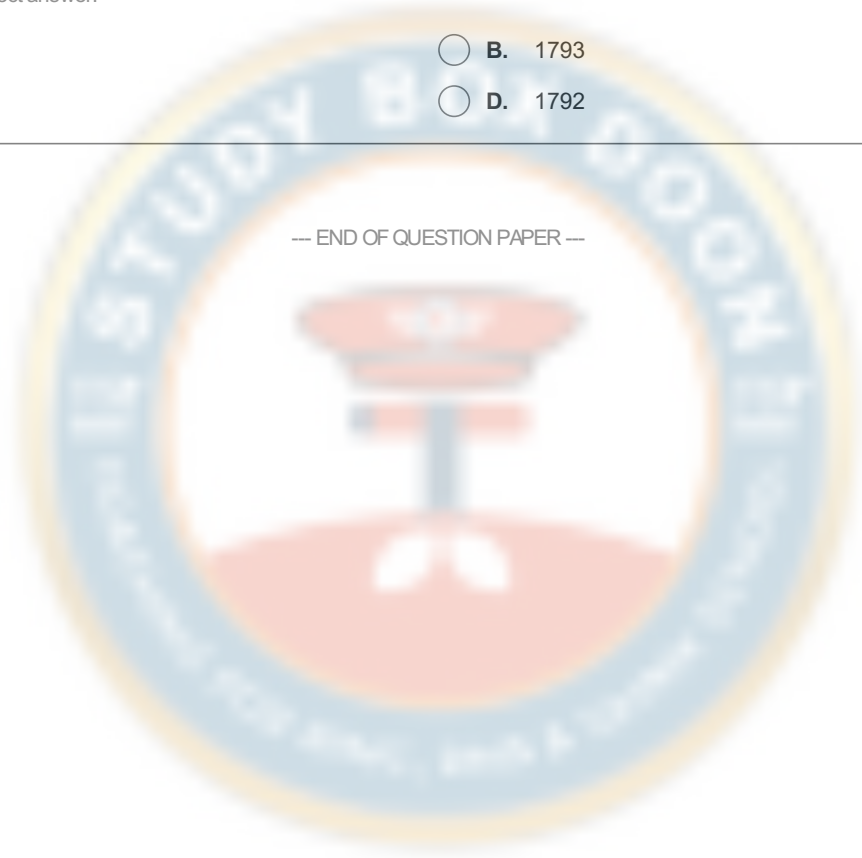
